These past months have been very difficult for many families with church and school closures. Many have not been to Mass in months. Some have to do a lot of their schooling from home. Teachers and catechists are also facing many challenges as most of our learning has moved online.

Yes, Lord! is a 25-minute show, structured as a Liturgy of the Word, aimed at children, ages 6-9. It is designed to help prepare children for Sunday Mass, or, in some cases, to replace the viewing of Mass on TV or the internet.

Children will enjoy the songs, the readings, the lessons, the prayers and the weekly activities as they journey through Lent towards Easter. Younger children will love the music, while older ones will prefer the lessons. Parents will appreciate that their children are engaging with the Word and are growing in the Faith.

Each episode will include all the parts of a Catholic Liturgy of the Word and will be hosted by Salt + Light Media's Deacon Pedro Guevara-Mann, who will lead the children in prayer. The music is provided by *Rhythm and Grace*, a group comprised of the Alex and Miriam Duketow and their 9 children.
