Our motto: "Christ's love compels us", as well as the passion charisma of our Founding Mother Józefa Hałacińska, have been an inspiration and a source of spiritual power during our continuous service for our Polish brothers and sisters. Our work for the community we shared with our priests, Franciscans and with the faithful, consisted of preparing the liturgical setting for all Polish Masses and liturgies such as May, Lenten or Rosary. She taught us tirelessly to put patriotism and Polish language as well as putting faith and love of thy neighbour into action. Sister Gaudentia took over the leading role in promoting these beautiful values and we followed – each in her own way.
